

***TARDY
POLICY
2010/2011***



1. Students are given five minutes passing time to gather their materials and use the restroom before reporting to class. If they do not report to class on time, they are marked tardy. Once they have accumulated three tardies, the teacher warns them that they have exhausted their free passes for the trimester, and a call home is made by the teacher.
2. In the event that a student should receive a fourth tardy in one class, the teacher will call home, and the student is referred to the office where they are scheduled for a one hour after school detention.
3. Should the student continue to come late to class, additional detentions will be assigned. Students are given a clean slate at the beginning of each trimester.

***Classroom Discipline Procedures
2010/2011***



1. Students are expected to conduct themselves appropriately in class. Should a student choose to disrupt the students around them, the teacher will attempt to redirect the behavior in order to maintain the academic integrity of the classroom.
2. Should the disruptive behavior continue, the student will be written up and escorted to the office. A phone call from the teacher will follow, along with a scheduled after school detention by the assistant principal.
3. In the event that the undesirable behavior continues, the student will be suspended out of school in order to preserve the educational rights of the other students. A reflection sheet must be completed and turned into the office before the student can return to school.
