



CLASSROOM DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

1. A student will receive two warnings from a teacher regarding his/her undesirable or disruptive behavior.
 2. Once a third warning is issued, the teacher may choose to give a lunch detention, or refer the student to the office for a **one hour** after school detention.
 3. Once a student has been referred to the office and has received his/her first detention, their next referral for that teacher will result in a **two hour** after school detention.
 4. A student's third referral to the office will result in an out of school suspension. The length of the suspension will be determined by the seriousness of the offense.
- This includes classroom and hallway behavior violations.
 - Fighting and other serious offenses will result in an immediate out of school suspension.
